
Appendix 1: Combined Landscape Character Type maps

The following series of maps show the extent of the coverage of each of the combined Landscape Character Types across the Isle of Wight.

These are a result of combing the information from the Isle of Wight Landscape Character Assessment, the West Wight Landscape Character Assessment and the East Wight Landscape Character Assessment. Its use prevents any risk of double counting of results when analysing datasets by landscape character type.

The following pie chart shows the proportion of each of the combined Landscape Character Types.






Figure 1 Combined Landscape Character Assessment Type - Arable Farmland (brown)




Figure 2 Combined Landscape Character Assessment Type - Chalk Downs (yellow/green)




Figure 3 Combined Landscape Character Assessment Type - Changed Countryside (red)




Figure 4 Combined Landscape Character Assessment Type - Coastal Designed Landscapes (purple)




Figure 5 Combined Landscape Character Assessment Type - Coastal Farmland (pink)




Figure 6 Combined Landscape Character Assessment Type – Estuaries (blue)




Figure 7 Combined Landscape Character Assessment Type - Pasture Lands (green)




Figure 8 Combined Landscape Character Assessment Type - Sandstone and Gravel (orange brown)




Figure 9 Settlement outside of Island Plan hierarchy (grey)




Figure 10 Combined Landscape Character Assessment Type - The Undercliff (purple)




Figure 11 Combined Landscape Character Assessment Type - Valley Floor (blue)




Figure 12 Combined Landscape Character Assessment Type – Woodlands




Figure 13 Island Plan Settlement Hierarchy areas with defined settlement boundaries
